Re: Recruitment for Post Of Probationary Assistant Superintendent of Police.

At the outset, the 68th Executive Committee, Sri Lanka Police Inspectors' Association (ExCo / SLPIA) wishes to express our sincere gratitude to the Officials of the National Police Commission (NPC) for inviting us to hold discussions on Promotions of the Inspectorate on 03rd May 2019.

We are very much pleased to note about the sincere concern shown when we presented facts and exchanged views specifically on the problems related to the promotions of the Inspectorate and when we inquired about the process of recruitment, for the Post of Probationary Assistant Superintendents of Police, the NPC replied verbally that only 05 candidates will be recruited.

The outcome of the above communiqué in turn was conveyed promptly to our members of the Executive Committee during our monthly meeting held recently. Many of our members were satisfied when they heard the decision taken by the NPC.

But we were disappointed, distressed and disheartened when we saw the text displayed in the Official Web Site of the NPC on 20th July 2019 under caption – "Date to hold Competitive Examination for the Post of Probationary Assistant Superintendents of Police 2015 " 27/11/2017" and the under mentioned applicants totaling 18 were selected by the NPC for recruitment to the rank of P/ASPP when they met on 18/07/2019 along with letters furnished with details.

During our discussion held with the NPC we have emphasized and pointed out the vital fact, that by taking such a course of action, to recruit a large number of applicants for the post of P/ASPP which in turn may deprive and limit the chances of many senior officers of the Inspectorate to promote to the rank of ASPP.

Further, as assured by the NPC during our discussions held recently, we are still fully confident that the NPC would hold the Limited Competitive Examination for those serving officers in the Sri Lanka Police for the Post of Assistant Superintendent of Police.


Lastly, in connection with the above and other connected problems faced by the Inspectorate, we request you most respectfully to grant us a date and time for discussion at your earliest convenience.
