Re: Request to reconsider to reduce the number of direct recruitment of Probationary ASP.

It is with due respect, the 68th Executive Committee, Sri Lanka Police Inspectors' Association (Ex.Co.SLPia) refers this appeal for your serious consideration, further to our correspondence bearing No.SLPia Out/130/19 dated 06th August 2019 on the above noted request (Copy of correspondence is attached)

The salient facts related to our appeal are referred to below.

The Official Web Site of the NPC displayed on 20th July 2019 about its decision taken to recruit 18 P/ASPP in due course.

But as per the drafted SOR (Scheme of Recruitment) which will be effected with a retrospective effect by 29.07.2017, 10% is allocated from the available vacancies for the Post of P/ASP.

The Ex.Co/SLPIA strongly feels that in reality if the NPC is determined to adopt its decision to recruit 18 Applicants aspiring for the Post of P/ASPP materialize; it would affect very seriously the deserving senior Chief Inspectors of Police from gaining the legitimate promotions.

Furthermore, the ExCo/SLPIA strongly believes that if such recruitment of 18 personals of P/ASPP will take place, it will contradict with the SOR which will eventually be affected the whole hierarchy of Sri Lanka Police.

Simultaneously, if such a course of action is taken, it will be a serious denial or an act of depriving the deserving Senior Chief Inspectors of Police.

In the light of the above, the Ex.Co. SLPIA most respectfully appeals to the National Police Commission to reconsider its decision and to act in terms of the SOR of Sri Lanka Police as to fill the existing vacancies on the basis of 70% from the seniority, 20% from the competitive exam and 10% from direct recruitment.
